

**BENEFICIARIES' AND PLAN'S RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES UPON
DISENROLLMENT:**

CarePlus Health Plans, Inc. (CPHP) will provide the member with a written disenrollment notice within ten (10) calendar days of receipt of the request to disenroll. The disenrollment notice will include an explanation of the lock-in restrictions for the period during which the member was enrolled in CPHP, and the effective date of disenrollment. Beginning on the effective date of the member's disenrollment, CPHP will not cover any health care the member receives. In addition, beginning on the effective date of the member's disenrollment, the member can see a doctor through the original Medicare Plan, unless the member has enrolled in another Medicare Advantage HMO Plan. If the member's doctor(s) need to send claims to Medicare, the member may want to let the doctor(s) know that he/she just disenrolled from CPHP, and that it may take a few weeks for Medicare to update its computer records.
